How many of you would say you are creative?

Creativity – the ability to bring something into existence, to produce or bring about by a course of action or behavior, to bring into being, beget, give birth to, cause to grow.

In the beginning, **God created** the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1

So God **created** man **in his own image**, in the image of God he **created** him; male and female he **created** them. Genesis 1:27

There is something powerful about the kind of creativity that <u>creates</u> room for <u>others</u>.

The Christian should be the person who is alive, whose imagination absolutely boils, which moves, which produces something a bit different from God's world because **God made us to be creative**. Francis Schaeffer

Creativity can happen when our *world* intersects with God's *Good News*.

And in the same region there were **shepherds out in the field**, keeping watch over their flock by night. And **an angel of the Lord** appeared to them, and **the glory of the Lord** shone around them, and they were filled with great fear. And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, **I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.** For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be **a sign for you**: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger." Luke 2:8-12

When the angels went away from them into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "**Let us go** over to Bethlehem and **see this thing** that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us." Luke 2:15

Creativity can create a **treasure** of **wonder** and awe.

And they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger. And when they saw it, they made known the saying that had been told them concerning this child. And all who heard it wondered at what the shepherds told them. But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart. And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them. Luke 2:16-20
