Clothing Guidelines

Students will need to wear jeans/capris. No holes in the jeans and also no white jeans. They should wear an appropriate t-shirt on Friday/Sat and will wear their mission trip t-shirt on Sunday, which we will give to them. All clothing should reflect modesty & discretion. These are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> at any time: shorts, sheer clothing, mid-drifts, bellies or low-cut dress necklines, deep armholes, spaghetti straps, or strapless tops. Guys must wear pants at the top of their hips, & keep their shirts on at all times.
